Falmouth Museums on the Green, home of the Falmouth Historical Society, sit on two acres overlooking the Falmouth Village Green.

The 1790 Wicks House displays furniture, fine art, toys and textiles, through which we see how the townspeople lived over the centuries. One special exhibit depicts the art of pre-Civil War medicine practiced by Dr. Wicks. (Be happy you live today!)

The Visitors Center is located in the Hallett Barn, a welcoming place with exhibits on Falmouth' past as well as the Whaling Wives Gift Shop.



Members of the Falmouth Garden Club maintain

three delightful gardens on the grounds. Visitors are welcome to stroll or relax in the gardens during daylight hours year-round.



The newly renovated 1730 Conant House, open year-round, has changing exhibits, This building also houses our offices, archives and the Collis Research Library, open by appointment.
