2016 Annual Report Information

2016 was a year in which the focus was the restoration and renovation of the 1730 Conant House. The project, which was undertaken by Cape Associates from Yarmouth, MA, began construction in December 2015 and finished in October 2016. A dry and hot summer affected weekly visitation, but the Museums held a number of programs and events that drew large crowds, including:

- Thirty-seven lectures were held, including appearances by Nathaniel Philbrick, Michael Holley, Ian Toll, Jerry Thornton, Nathalia Holt, Alice Dreger and Paul Brandus. The Philbrick lecture, held at the 1st Congregational Church, drew an audience of nearly 400 people
- The Museums on the Green introduced two new events: the 5K Walk for History, held on May 22, and the Historic House Tour of Falmouth Village Green. Each drew enthusiastic crowds.
- The 17th annual Heritage Award was held in April and had a maritime theme, honoring the Tietje family of Falmouth and retiring Admiral Thomas Bushey of Massachusetts Maritime Academy
- Other events were reprised from previous years, including the 'Around the Sound' cruise, Cape Cod Hydrangea Festival, Katharine Lee Bates Poetry Fest, 47th annual Antique Sale, 'A Visit with the Night Watchman', and the Holiday Traditions Tour of the 1790 Dr. Francis Wicks House
- For the third year in a row, the Museums on the Green was a participant in the Highland Street Foundation's "Free Fun Friday" program, drawing large audiences to Falmouth as the grant paid for their admission
- Children's programs included the annual Teddy Bear Picnic and Animal World Adventures
- School programs featured visits from all of the third grade classes from all five Falmouth elementary schools and visits to the 7th grade classrooms at the Lawrence School
- Collaborative events included the annual "Inspired by Nature" educational program, teaming up with the Falmouth School Department, Cape Cod Symphony, Falmouth Art Center, Salt Pond Areas Bird Sanctuaries and the National Oceanographic and Atmospheric Association (NOAA); the Falmouth School Department on two ceramics projects; Arts Falmouth on the annual Jazz Stroll; the Falmouth Village Association on a Mother's Day event and a Christmas event; the Falmouth Garden Club on the Holiday Traditions Tour; and the Falmouth Chamber of Commerce on a Business after Hours
- Several nonprofits in Falmouth and the region used the Cultural Center for their own events, including the 300 Committee for a series of winter lectures; the Falmouth Village Association for business meetings; the women's empowerment group WE CAN for their monthly meetings; and Memory Café for their monthly meetings. The local Girl Scouts also held events at our facility.
- Thirty-six very well-attended walking tours were conducted throughout the visitation season (Tuesday and Thursday mornings), while five historic trolley tours were held in September and October.
