Event Overview

The *Houses of the Revolution Tour* offers visitors a rare opportunity to step inside private homes with Revolutionary War—era ties. **All tour participants** will begin their day at the Falmouth Museums on the Green — Cultural Center (55 Palmer Avenue) to pick up tickets, maps, and guidebooks before heading to the homes. As an exhibitor, your booth will be located at this ticket pickup site — giving you access to all attendees before they begin their tour.

Exhibitor Fees

- Outdoor Field Space (Uncovered) \$30 if received by September 1; \$35 after September 1
- Indoor Cultural Center Space \$50 if received by September 1; \$55 after September 1 (Indoor space is limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis)

Terms & Conditions

- Contracts are non-transferable; booth spaces may not be shared.
- Vendors may unload and pack up next to their tents beginning at 10a.m. (pack-up 2pm); parking is available at the Congregational Church next to the Museum.
- Event hours for exhibitor booths are 11:00 a.m.–2:00 p.m. Tour itself will be noon to 4pm, but we anticipate booth action for you between 11am and 2pm.
- The Falmouth Historical Society is not responsible for loss, damage, or injury to any person, goods, or merchandise.
- The event is held rain or shine; no refunds will be issued.
