



Summer Museum Education Intern

The Falmouth Museums on the Green is seeking a Museum Education intern for the spring of 2023 in memory of the late benefactor Caroline Lloyd. The intern will work closely with the Executive Director to implement a series of children and adult education programs including workshops, lectures, and hands on activities. The intern will be a skilled public speaker comfortable with diverse audiences including children, adults, and the elderly. The intern will work ten hours a week that will change based on programming. Preference will be given to student enrolled in a program in Public History, Museum Studies, and Education. Skills with digital engagement is also desirable. The work will be on site, with occasional projects from home. Compensation for the summer is a \$15 an hour for 10 hours per week, which will be paid bi- weekly. The internship would start May 15th until August 15th.
